The to switch to this AT & T is still in the process. There has been some issues and the fireman who are working with Comcast. There was not a fireman in attendance who is heading up the switching project to get a more detailed report.

Don Hundt Sr presented invoices for class A uniforms to be paid. These expenses were approved at last month's meeting.

Don Hundt Sr pointed out that there was no reimbursement check in this month's bills that were paid. It was approved to pay Tom Forkins' invoice for the Class A uniform he had just purchased. The amount to be paid was \$622.95. Treasurer Ron Sutton Jr will get this corrected.

Deputy Chief Steve Burt gave a report on how well the CEVO class has gone so far. Attendance was excellent from all of Township fire companies. There will be more sessions with the actual driving and inspections of the apparatus by attendees.
