January 5th 2026

Board President Cliff Sharp opened the meeting at 6:30 PM.

Old Business:

The to switch to this AT & T is still in the process. Currently we are waiting on Comcast to run some wires and then we can continue the changeover. There will be two WIFI's installed. One will be for the Fire Company and an additional one for public use when in the fire hall. Zach Klaudi and Ronald Sutton are overseeing the changes.

The 12 new safety vests have been delivered and handed out to all those firemen that needed them.

New Business:

Cliff Sharp announced that he would not be seeking another term on the Fire Commission.

Fred said that he has petitions and that it would be nice if we could find someone other than a firefighter or another Hundt to run for Cliff's position.

Fred said he had spoken to Seth Beaumont about this, and he seemed interested in the position. Seth is a businessman in the community.

Chiefs Comments:

Don Hundt Sr, spoke on behalf of Chief Don Jr, who is sick. The fit testing has been completed by all but one firefighter who said he will do the test after he shaves.

Don also reported that members need to test with masks being used by other fire fighters to get proper fits. It's been determined that we need to purchase 3 new masks at a cost of \$1230. The motion was made by Ron Sutton and seconded by Ron Hundt Sr to purchase.

Don Sr also discussed driver training. That's due to an accident a few weeks ago there will be inquiries about driver training. The County Fire School is currently meeting to discuss CEVO driver training in the county. Done under State guidelines with certified County Fire School instructors.

Ron Sutton suggested that we run this possible training past our current insurance company to get their thoughts on this training. It was suggested that insurance companies offer these training services free of charge. All this is speculation and Fred offered to contact the Commissioners agent tomorrow. He will tell our agency (Mints insurance) that we need to get answers quickly because the fire company is in the early stages of getting this driver training started in a few weeks.

Don Hundt Sr also reported that the fire company ran 172 Fire and EMS calls in the year 2025 which is about a normal year.

Public Portion:

The meeting was opened to the public and there was nothing from the public.

Mr Solof from INFORM THE VOTE was in attendance and he has a few questions on posted minutes on the web site. Most of his questions were answered and will get corrected.

The public portion was closed.
