

Board of Fire Commissioners, District II

May 4th, 2026

Board President Vice President Ron Hundt Sr opened the meeting at 6:30 PM.

The American Flag was then saluted, and the Lord's Prayer was recited.

Members participating were:

Commissioners Ronald Hundt Sr, Ron Sutton Jr. and Fred Hundt.

Minutes

The minutes of the April 6th meeting were sent to all via email. Motion was made to accept the minutes by Ron Sutton Jr and was seconded by Ron Hundt Sr. All the Board members present voted to approve the minutes from the April 6th commissioner meeting.

Treasurers Report:

Ron Sutton Jr handed out the detailed treasurer report that was given to him by our accounting office. The report reflected all transactions made since the last meeting and current balance sheets.

The ending check balance was \$82,330.71 The fund balance of checking and savings is \$326,394.64. The total assets of the district as shown are \$497,986.62. Motion to accept the report and pay the bills was made by Fred Hundt. and was seconded by Ronald Hundt Sr.

At this time Ronald Sutton Jr discussed with the Board some notes that were supplied to him by accountants for tonight's meeting. They have advised the Board that we do not have a specific line item for the class A fireman uniforms and that they will apply this cost to the turnout gear line item.

The iPads that were just purchased will be applied to the line item of office supplies. The office supplies line will show over budget and will be adjusted at the end of the year when the adjustments are made to the line items in the annual budget.

These points were discussed and it was decided that the accountants know best and it was fine with the commission on their decisions to the placements of expenses.

The accountants asked about two CD's that are about to mature and asked for our thoughts on just rolling over the two CD's that are with the 1st Bank of Sea Isle City.

After some discussion on this the board decided that the CD's should be rolled over for 6 months at 3.5%. Ronald Sutton will advise the accountants of the Boards decisions.

Fred Hundt then made a motion to pay all bills for next month's period, and it was seconded by Ron Hundt Sr.

Old Business:

The first of the old business was fixing the building's large generator. Don Hundt Sr reported to the commission that the electrician did not come today. We are hoping that the electrician comes tomorrow to change the controller.

The switch to this AT & T is almost completed. The issues have been resolved, and the fireman are completing some hard wiring to workstations and the TVs.

Deputy Chief Steve Burt gave a report on how well the CEVO class went. There will be more sessions with the actual driving and inspections of the apparatus by attendees.

Chief Don Hundt Jr stated that he has obtained the new iPads for the apparatus and will be installed soon.

New Business:

Fred Hundt reported that he has received the annual audit from Colavita's office. The audit stated that the Fire District had no deficiencies or weaknesses and that we have met the standards of NJ Department of Community Affairs.

Chiefs Comments:

Deputy Chief Steve Burt stated that 1202 had a power steering box leak and it was repaired. He also stated that 1201 has a problem with the fuel pick tube and that this

tube is part of the actual fuel tank. A new fuel tank had to be ordered and will be replaced. In the meantime, Steve suggested that the fuel tank always stay half full.

Chief Don Hundt Jr reported that there is a Bayshore drill scheduled to be held in Mauricetown on June 6th. This will be a tender and drafting drill. The drill will try to achieve a minimum flow of 1000 GPM.

Chief Hundt reported that Mark Sheppard has been looking at the starting up of the pump on the Morie property. Mark stated that the battery is bad and needs to be replaced. The Board gave Mark the approval to get a new battery and get the pumping station operational. Hopefully it will be up and running by the June 6th drill here in Mauricetown.

Public Portion:

The meeting was opened to the public. There was nothing addressed to the commission. The public portion was then closed.
